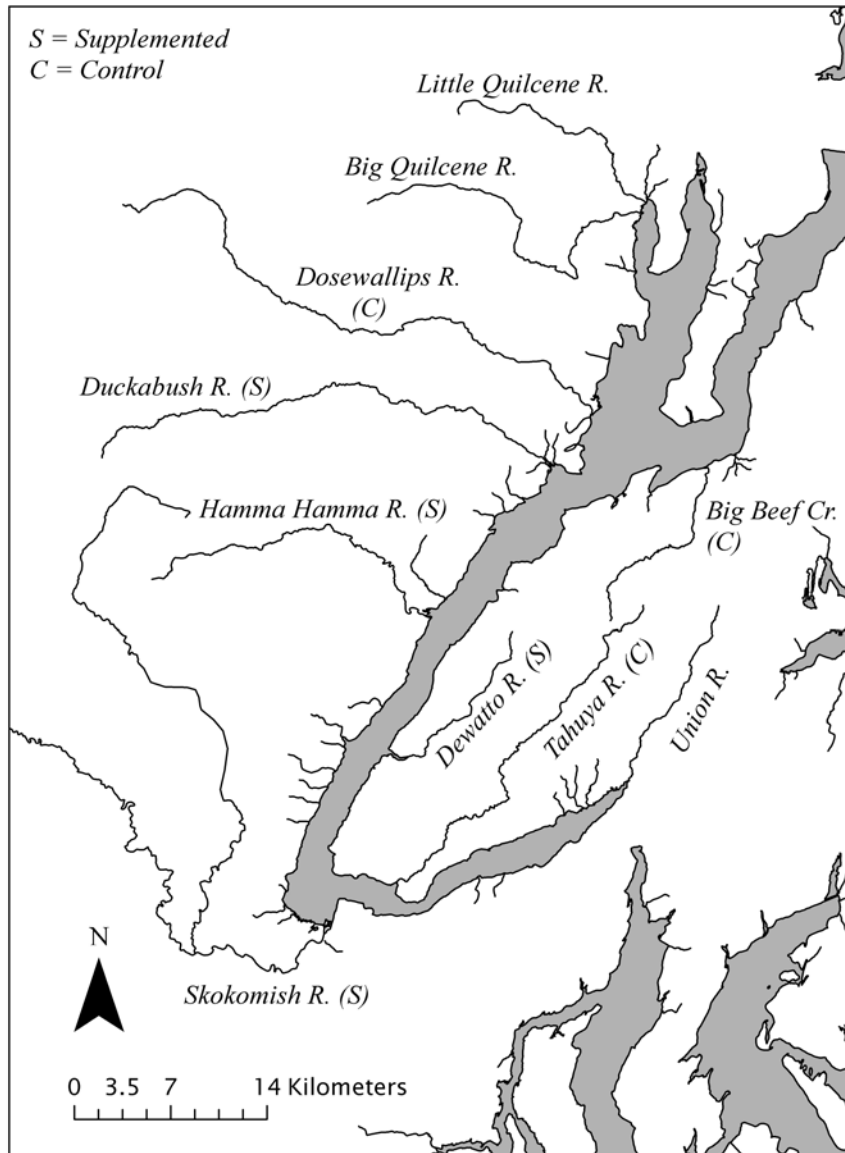


The Hood Canal Steelhead Project

The Hood Canal Steelhead Project is a basin-wide expansion of innovative steelhead rearing and monitoring techniques developed on the Hamma Hamma River. This first-of-its-kind supplementation experiment incorporates all steelhead-bearing Hood Canal river systems and is expected to last for 16 years.
